




BOARD BITS

Artificial Turf & Statue Relocation Project

Community Planning Advisory Group (CPAG)

There are two exciting projects that will be started soon and hopefully completed by the end of the year. They are the installation of artificial turf at select locations and the relocation of four statues. The Landscaping and Beautification Working Group (LBWG) are coordinating both projects to be done in coordination because some of the relocated statue locations will also be installed with artificial turf adjacent to them.

The current plan is to initially install **Artificial Turf** as pilots at the entrance leading into the Trailhead Members Club off Ridgecrest and at the entrance of Power Road and Eagle Crest Drive. Additional sites have been identified pending the results of these pilots. Artificial grass is relatively maintenance free and looks great all year around. Additionally, artificial turf, which has a manufacturer's warranty of 15 years, typically has a cost payback of less than 5 years through savings on watering, mowing, fertilizing and over-seeding. The quality of the turf is top of the line and will look almost like natural well-maintained grass.

Below is a picture of the artificial turf which was installed as part of the beautification project directly in front of the Trailhead building in April 2017. The resident feedback on this has been very positive.



Statue Relocation was chosen for the following statues: Thomas Merton, Paul Robeson, Albert Camus and Rabbi Abraham Heschel. Each of these statues is currently located in a remote location, which are rarely accessed by community members. The intent is to display them in higher traffic areas where appreciation for this artwork can be maximized.



LANDSCAPE UPDATE

Boulder Mountain Parke Grass is Taking a Rest

Starting in Mid-September, overseeding (winter rye grass) will begin for all turf areas throughout the community - except for Boulder Mountain Parke. The Association has started a program of resting one of the five large parks every year to help strengthen the health of those areas over time.

This means that the Boulder Mountain Parke bermuda (summer) grass will be allowed to turn dormant over winter and will bounce back healthier in the spring. Other smaller areas that will be taking a rest are in Grayfox, Trailridge and Windsong. Keep in mind that grass will turn brown over the winter months. Please note, you will still be able to use these areas during time of rest.

So...How does this work and why is it good to do?

When an area is being over-seeded, the existing bermuda grass is usually "scalped" to remove most of the green grass and allow the ryegrass (winter) seed time to become established. The bermuda is then forced to compete for water, nutrients, and sun with the newly planted rye grass.

This results in the bermuda grass being in a weaker health condition when entering winter dormancy in November. The following spring, still lacking energy from dormancy and again competing with the rye grass, the bermuda has difficulty re-establishing itself. The bermuda will continue to struggle until the rye has died when temperatures reach 100 degrees.

Some of the additional benefits of non-over-seeded bermuda lawns:

- Savings on the cost of seed and fertilizer for new rye grass.
- Savings of irrigation water costs because dormant bermuda grass requires substantially less water.
- A stronger stand of bermuda grass means fewer weed problems and less money spent on weed control chemicals.


COMPLIANCE - Pool Water Discharge

According to City of Mesa ordinance (Chapter 1, Section 6-1-14) it is unlawful to pump the water from your pool and allow it to drain onto a street. Additionally, it is not allowed as stated in our Architectural Guidelines, pg. 5.

The two ways that an owner can discharge water from the pool are:

- 1. Contain the water in the rear yard. Note: This will work for routine backwashing; however, to completely drain a pool, method #2 should be used.
- 2. The discharge water should be pumped down the proper sewer Clean-out located at the front of your home. (See diagram).

Under NO circumstances should pool water be pumped or drained into a common area. (See Architectural Guidelines, pg. 5).

REMINDER! See a leak? Let us know!

Architectural Committee

The Custom Architectural Review Committee meets the first and third Thursday of the month while the Regular Architectural Review Committee meets the second and fourth Thursday, The ARC committees are comprised of Las Sendas homeowner volunteers and reviews all architectural applications submitted.

The purpose of the Architectural Committee is to review and analyze requests to make improvements to the visible exterior of a home and make sure the improvements stay within the guidelines set forth in our CC&R's.

In an effort to provide and protect each individual homeowner's rights and property values, it is required that any Las Sendas Homeowner that is considering improvements to their home which modify the exterior of the home submit an application to the Architectural Committee prior to starting work on any planned im-

provements. Work may begin as soon as the homeowner receives written confirmation that their planned improvement has been approved.

It is the purpose of the Architectural Committee and the Guidelines to promote those qualities in Las Sendas that enhance the attractiveness and functionality of the community. Those qualities include a harmonious relationship among structures, vegetation (weeds not included), topography and overall design of the community. Some examples of improvements are landscaping (plants, grass, hardscape), painting, security screen doors, sun screens, lighting, just to name a few.

"Barchester Towers"
by Anthony Trollope, 500 pages

Published in 1857, it is the second novel in Anthony Trollope's series known as the "Chronicles of Barsetshire". Among other things it satirizes the then raging antipathy in the Church of England

between High Church and Evangelical adherents. Trollope began writing this book in 1855. He wrote constantly, and made himself a writing-desk so he could continue writing while travelling by train. "Pray know that when a man begins writing a book he never gives over," he wrote in a letter during this period. "The evil with which he is beset is as inveterate as drinking – as exciting as gambling." And, years later in his autobiography, he observed "In the writing of Barchester Towers I took great delight. The bishop and Mrs. Proudie were very real to me, as were also the troubles of the archdeacon and the loves of Mr. Slope." But when he submitted his

finished work, his publisher, William Longman, initially turned it down, finding much of it to be full of "vulgarity and exaggeration." More recent critics offer a more sanguine opinion. "Barchester Towers is many readers' favorite Trollope", wrote The Guardian, which included it in its list of "1000 novels everyone must read."

In Holt, Colorado, widower Louis Waters is initially thrown when the widowed Addie Moore suggests that they spend time together, in bed, to stave off loneliness. They are soon exchanging the
